

Charlotte Mason Society Library Policies

Participating Members will pay a yearly membership fee of \$75 per student. This money will be used to purchase more Charlotte Mason approved books and other learning materials for use by all members of the Society.

The Charlotte Mason Society has a limited number of books and materials which may be checked out. Please consider the other families that could benefit from the use of books and return them in a timely manner. If you habitually maintain overdue items, your library privileges may be revoked.

The leadership of the Charlotte Mason Society will provide approved curriculum materials for the student's course work according to the P.U.O. booklist. The lending library will also maintain an optional approved reading section as listed in the 1000 Best Books List recommended by Charlotte Mason advocates.

Students may "join" the PUO curriculum list at any time during the year and books will be dispersed accordingly as supply limitations will allow.

The Charlotte Mason Society's goal is to develop a well stocked resource center for parents to use. When a student is finished with his/her curriculum, these items will be returned for use by another student or family.

The lending library is supported solely by it's members. We ask that you not check out items and then "loan" them to friends that are not members.

We request that each family use extreme care when using the books. Many of the books required by the PUO are old or out-of-print and are irreplaceable. Please refrain from eating or drinking when reading the books. Do not "crack" the binding or leave the book open and lying face down. Always use a book-mark to hold your place. This will help ensure a longer life for the wear of the book.

When a family returns an item that is damaged, they will be charged to replace that item.

If you lose an item, you will be expected to pay the replacement cost of that item.
